
Where you park your car affects other people, whether it be a safety or obstruction issue. This is why Parking Rangers patrol to make sure we all share the road safely and equally.

If you have received a parking penalty notice, you need to finalise the matter within twenty-one days to ensure that further action isn't taken against you by Revenue NSW.






## **ROAD RULE #179** DO NOT PARK IN A 'LOADING ZONE' A driver must not park in a loading zone. You may pull into a loading zone only to drop off or pick up a passenger. **FINE \$215**

A driver must not stop on a bicycle path, footpath,

shared path, dividing strip or a nature strip adjacent
