NSW Police, Cooma Police Station, Thursday 21 November 2024

Summary of Key Points:

- Notable issues: Operation Amarak active in Monaro Command dealing with Domestic Violence (DV). This is one of the NSW Commissioner's top priorities. Monaro Command Police pro-active in unannounced and random AVO compliance checks and operate on a zero-tolerance policy.
- 35 cases reported in Monaro in 2024 however, Police suspect much 'under reporting'. One case per month (on average) in Bungendore and Braidwood combined.
- DV reports can be made on the NSW Police website portal and through Service NSW.
- Queanbeyan bus interchange assault issues remaining a concern. So far seven offenders before courts. Police actively patrolling area but not every day.
- Crime rates (QPRC LGA):
 - Assault Licensed Premises remain low.
 - Assault DV decreasing but still higher than average.
 - Sexual Assault decreasing and already below average.
 - Break and Enter steady but increase in rural crime with firearms, farm equipment, trailers and high-end fertilizers most attractive.
 - Car Theft rate decreased and now on par with the average.
 - Increase in Malicious Damage rate (random and opportunistic vandalism, graffiti etc). Vandalism and graffiti in Bungendore's former Community Centre and Council Chambers noted for investigation.
 - Shoplifting steady with most being reoffenders.
 - Drug possession and supply steady and below average.
